**INSTRUCTIONS**

The Arizona AER Scholarship Project is sponsoring one \$500 Merit Award recognizing an outstanding visually impaired student. Applicants must be currently attending a post-secondary educational program or be completing their last year of high school, along with having central acuity of 20/70 or less with best correction or a significant peripheral field loss of 20° or less. In addition to the Application Information Sheet, applicants must submit the following items:

1. Two letters of recommendation: one from a current AZ AER member who will act as your sponsor and one from an academic advisor, teacher or community leader
2. A typewritten essay of no more than two pages describing the applicant's educational, professional and personal goals and how this award will help achieve these goals
3. A certified copy of the applicant's student transcripts from the school or institution in which the student is currently enrolled.
4. A vitae or résumé of the applicant's work experience, extra-curricular activities and honors.

All completed applications must be submitted and postmarked by the deadline date of June 1, 2008 to:
